

# WARNING TO CANDIDATES

1. You **must** be on time for all your examinations.
2. Possession of an **unnecessary mobile device** (a device being used to provide access to the online platform is permitted) or other unauthorised material is **not allowed** - even if you do not intend to use it. You will be subject to penalty and possible disqualification from the exam/qualification.
3. You **must not** talk to, attempt to communicate with or disturb other candidates once you have entered the examination room.
4. You **must** follow the instructions detailed at the beginning of your assessment.
5. You **must not** sit an examination in the name of another candidate.
6. You **must not** become involved in any unfair or dishonest practice in any part of the examination.
7. You **must not** ask the Proctor questions about the assessment.
8. If you have technical difficulties and cannot access your assessment, please notify the Proctor.

The **Warning to candidates** must be displayed in a prominent place outside each examination room. This may be a hard copy A4 paper version or an image of the poster projected onto a wall or screen for all candidates to see.
