

LIFT TRUCK INSTRUCTOR – COURSE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

LIFT TRUCK INSTRUCTOR INITIAL

- Proof of successful completion of the full eTruck eLearning course within 36 months of the course start date.
- Documentary evidence of having completed a Counterbalance course of Basic Operating Skills within 36 months of the course start date. The operator course must have been conducted by a currently registered AITT, ITSSAR, LANTRA, NPORS or RTITB Instructor.

LIFT TRUCK INSTRUCTOR 5-DAY RE-REGISTRATION (Standard)

- Proof of successful completion of the refresher eTruck eLearning course within 36 months of the course start date.
- RTITB Registration Number or RTITB Lift Truck Instructor Certificate (current or expired within the last 24 months).

Note: if the candidate's RTITB instructor qualification expired more than 24 months ago, the candidate will be treated as a Novice candidate and will need to attend a 10-day course.

LIFT TRUCK INSTRUCTOR 3-DAY RE-REGISTRATION (Accelerated)

- Proof of successful completion of the refresher eTruck eLearning course within 36 months of the course start date.
- RTITB Registration Number or RTITB Lift Truck Instructor Certificate (current or expired within the last 24 months).
- High levels of instructional ability, conducted basic operator training on a frequent basis within the registration period.

LIFT TRUCK INSTRUCTOR 5-DAY CONVERSION

- Proof of successful completion of the full eTruck eLearning course within 36 months of the course start date.
- Current Lift Truck Instructor Certificate issued by an Accrediting Bodies Association for Workplace Transport (ABA) member, or hold one of the following qualifications (current or expired within that last 12 months):
 - o Registered RTITB LGV/ICI Instructor
 - o IPAF Instructor
 - o CITB/Construction Skills Instructor
 - o ALLMI Instructor
 - o LEEA Instructor

- o PASMA Instructor
- o ROSPA International Diploma in Advanced Instruction o ROSPA International Master Training
- o IIPMM Instructor (Ireland)
- o BRITTOP Instructor

- For all of the above, documentary evidence of having completed a Counterbalance course of Basic Operating Skills within 36 months of the course start date. The operator course must have been conducted by a currently registered AITT, ITSSAR, LANTRA, NPORS or RTITB Instructor.

Note: this course is not suitable for holders of in-house instructor qualifications. Holders of in-house instructor qualifications need to complete the initial course.
