

Driver CPC Golden Rules

Whilst everything within this guidance is of upmost importance and is to be adhered to on all occasions, this section has been included to highlight the most important aspects of Driver CPC Periodic Training delivery. These four golden rules have been identified as the top issues by DVSA. Failure to comply with the rules listed below will usually result in at least a level 5 sanction as they affect the whole consortium's security, and therefore errors will not be taken lightly. We may also deem it necessary to disallow the hours to be uploaded to DVSA, which will disadvantage the driver and may affect your business relations.

- 1) Periodic Training cannot be less than the DVSA approved course time
- 2) ID checks must be conducted correctly and before course commencement
- 3) Data protection must be fully addressed and dealt with
- 4) Courses must be delivered as approved by DVSA
