- Be able to plan and deliver Driver CPC Periodic Training
- Be able to recall and discuss the role and responsibilities of a Driver CPC instructor.

All candidates must successfully complete an independent examination to qualify as a Driver CPC instructor - attaining an internationally recognised qualification. Successful candidates are eligible to register on the National Register of LGV Instructors (NRI) as a Driver CPC instructor.

The Driver CPC Instructor Training course covers the following core topics:

#### **EXAMINATION:**

- 1. Theory examination the theory examination comprises 70 multiple-choice questions in 75 minutes. It covers instructional techniques, driving legislation, The Highway Code, and eco-safe driving.
- 2. In-class assessment this classroom instruction examination lasts 30 minutes and requires candidates to deliver a pre-prepared, classroom-based lesson on a subject pre-allocated from a bank of 8 topics.
