

LIFT TRUCK ASSESSOR - COURSE CONTENT AND OVERVIEW

The Lift Truck Assessor course provides candidates with the skills to assess and report on the proficiency of material handling equipment (MHE) operators prior to employment/authorisation to work. The course also prepares candidates to carry out assessments.

It does not prepare them to deliver remedial training. If this is required for your business, the <u>Lift Truck</u> <u>Instructor</u> course would be the most appropriate course, as this covers assessing and instructing. Courses are available at the RTITB Instructor Academy in Telford, UK, on your site, or as <u>remote instructor training</u> for the theory element of the course.

BY THE END OF THE LIFT TRUCK ASSESSOR COURSE CANDIDATES WILL:

- Be able to recall and discuss the duties and responsibilities of a lift truck assessor
- Be able to conduct operator assessments
- Be able to produce factual, informative reports.

Candidates must successfully complete an independent examination to register on the <u>RTITB Register of</u> Professional Instructors and Assessors.

THE LIFT TRUCK ASSESSOR COURSE IS SUITABLE FOR CANDIDATES WHO:

- Have significant experience as a lift truck operator
- Have proof of successfully completing the operator skills test within the last 3 years
- Have the confidence to objectively assess the performance of their peers

- MHE assessment procedures
- Skills and task analysis
- Assessment of the all 3 elements of the MHE basic skills test: pre-use inspection, practical driving and associated knowledge
- Operator test marking sheets





- Report writing
- Accident, truck defect and periodic driving assessments.

EXAMINATION:

In order to pass the Lift Truck Operator Assessor course, you will be required to pass an examination consisting of three elements:

- 1. Basic operator skills test all three elements (pre-use, practical and associated knowledge)
- 2. Associated knowledge test multiple choice theory paper, pass mark 80%
- 3. Assessment of practical operating ability test of the candidate's ability to conduct assessments
