

LOW LEVEL PALLET TRUCK INSTRUCTOR (A1, A2) – COURSE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

LOW LEVEL PALLET TRUCK INSTRUCTOR 5-DAY INITIAL

- Documentary evidence of having completed a Low Level Pallet Truck (A1/A2) course of Basic Operating Skills within 36 months of the course start date. The operator course must have been conducted by a currently registered AITT, ITSSAR, LANTRA, NPORS or RTITB Instructor.
- Proof of successful completion of the full eTruck eLearning course within 36 months of the course start date.

LOW LEVEL PALLET TRUCK INSTRUCTOR 3-DAY RE-REGISTRATION

- RTITB Registration Number or RTITB Lift Truck Instructor Certificate (current or expired within the last 12 months).
- Proof of successful completion of the refresher eTruck eLearning course within 36 months of the course start date.

Note: if the candidate's RTITB instructor qualification expired more than 24 months ago, the candidate will be treated as a Novice candidate and will need to attend a 5-day course.

LOW LEVEL PALLET TRUCK INSTRUCTOR 4-DAY CONVERSION

- Proof of successful completion of the full eTruck eLearning course within 36 months of the course start date.
- Current Low Level Pallet Truck Instructor Certificate issued by an Accrediting Bodies Association for Workplace Transport (ABA) member or hold one of the following qualifications (current or expired within that last 12 months).
 - Registered RTITB LGV/ICI Instructor
 - IPAF Instructor
 - CITB/Construction Skills Instructor
 - ALLMI Instructor
 - LEEA Instructor
 - PASMA Instructor
 - ROSPA International Diploma in Advanced Instruction
 - ROSPA International Master Training
 - IIPMM Instructor (Ireland)
 - BRITTOP Instructor

Note: this course is not suitable for holders of in-house instructor qualifications. Holders of in-house instructor qualifications need to complete the initial course.
